Academic Standing and Test Scores of the Applicant

1. REQUIRED: All grade point averages (GPA) must be based on the SC Uniform Grading Policy (SC UGP) and be cumulative through the END of the senior year. All GPAs must be reported with at least two decimal places and cannot be rounded. Please note that the reported GPAs must match the GPA submitted on the official high school transcript. All transcripts submitted must have a June 15th date calculated or earlier. No exceptions. **All eligible applicants must have a FINAL senior year transcript submitted on their behalf.**

SC Uniform Grading Policy Cumulative GPA: At the END of senior year, prior to June 15th.

2. OPTIONAL: If using rank in order for the student to be eligible to apply, the applicant must rank in the top six percent of the class at the END of either the sophomore, junior, or senior year before summer school prior to June 15th regardless of academic year being used (not the number in the class at the beginning of the next school year) based upon the SC UGP. Class size should include only diploma seeking candidates. You are only required to report the rank used to qualify the student for the Palmetto Fellows Scholarship (**If the student met rank several years, report only one year**).

*If the top six percent of the class is not already a whole number of students, you should round up to the next student.

*The reported class rank must match the class rank submitted on the official high school transcript and official high school ranking report.
